	<p>According to Table 3 FCP v 2.2, the RBF will be used to assess the PIs:</p> <p>2.2.1 as there are no biologically based limits available, derived either from analytical stock assessment or using empirical approaches.</p> <p>2.4.1 as limited information is available on habitats and the impact of fishing on those habitats.</p>
