<u>Announcement of Determination and Release of Final Report for Stakeholder</u> Consultation

Following a 30 day period of comment on the Draft Report, Global Trust Certification Ltd, has reviewed the report of the assessment team, the reports of the Peer Review panel and all stakeholder comments.

The Determination reached by the certification body is that the Scotian Shelf Snow Crab (Chionoecetes opilio) Trap Fishery using;

(Trap) SHOULD be certified according to the MSC Principles and Criteria
