## **Proposed variation**

To undertake the annual audit for the Canada northern and striped shrimp fisheries in Shrimp Fishing Areas (SFA) 2, 3, 4 outside of the annual reporting cycle and, to include within the same audit, the amended certifications for the Canada Northern Shrimp Trawl Fishery in SFA 5, 6 and SFA 7, as well as the Northern shrimp fisheries in SFA 1.

## **Rationale/Justification**

In order to achieve maximum efficiencies in time and cost for the clients and the management bodies associated with these fisheries, IMM proposes that the audits take place in November 2012 (as opposed to the original certification date of 20<sup>th</sup> March 2013 and 24<sup>th</sup> June 2012 for SFA 1 and SFAs 2-6 & 7, respectively. This will:

Allow the audit cycle for the fishery in SFA 1 to be synchronised with the other certified SFAs thus reducing the need for separate annual audits, i.e. SFA 1 was certified 9 months after the other SFAs.
Fit more appropriately with the annual stock assessment reporting cycle for these fisheries, i.e. the audits will take place soon after the stock assessments are released for the DFO managed fisheries in SFA 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 and NAFO managed fisheries in SFA 1 and 7.
