The request will not alter the conformity of the certified fisheries to the MSC Standard. The request for variation will allow for consideration and application of harmonisation with an overlapping certified MSC fishery (AAFA North Pacific Albacore tuna fishery) requirements consistent with procedure and also allow for additional information presented at the surveillance audit to be effectively reviewed.
