	Global Trust proposes to: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. postpone the upcoming surveillance audit, and.</li> <li>2. conduct the surveillance audit in late-September which will be more than 6 months later than the anniversary date as amended by MSC Derogation 1: Covid-19 pandemic.</li> </ol>

<b>3</b>	<b>Justification</b>	
	<p>The first surveillance audit of this fishery was announced on 16 July 2021 with the site visit portion of the audit to take place between 16 and 27 August 2021 (i.e. within 6 months of the anniversary date of the certificate as extended by MSC Covid Derogation 1). Unfortunately, due to unforeseen circumstances, a member of the assigned assessment team (the assessor primarily responsible for P1) has had to withdraw from participation in this audit. As 2 of the 3 open conditions relate to P1 and with new HCRs having been implemented since the initial assessment, it is important that the team includes an appropriately qualified P1 assessor.</p> <p>Global Trust has sourced an alternative P1 assessor but unfortunately the short notice has meant limited availability such that it has not been possible to organise key surveillance audit meetings within the previously announced timeframe. Global Trust therefore proposes to postpone and re-organise the audit for late-September/early-October 2021 but this will be more than 6 months after the certificate anniversary.</p> <p>Based on the above, Global Trust requests to be allowed to conduct the audit within 7 months (1 additional month) of the certificate anniversary.</p>

	There are no particular implications for the 1 <sup>st</sup> surveillance audit of this fishery.
