1. Proposed variation

IMM is requesting an extension of the current certificate by four months so there is no lapse in certification as the re-assessment process is completed.

2. Rationale/Justification

Preparation of the client draft report took longer than expected as a result of team member availability and follow up information requests.

3. Implications for assessment (required for fisheries assessment variations only)

The re-assessment team is completing the preliminary draft report for provision to the client for review and response to three conditions. The re-assessment determined that the fishery continues to operate consistently with the existing certification and the team is assured that the fishery will continue to do so in the period proposed for extension. IMM have no concerns that this extension will alter the conformity of the clients as holder of the certificate.

This combined assessment evaluates two current certification units. The current certificate for the Gulf of St. Lawrence Shrimp Trawl fishery, covering Shrimp Fishing Areas 9, 10, 12 is valid until 22 September 2013. The expected date of recertification is 31 January 2014 or sooner. The PDCR is expected to be published in December 2013, with a target eligibility date six months prior to coincide with the 2013 fishery currently underway. Assuming that the remainder of assessment proceeds without unforeseen complications, the target eligibility period and the remaining validity of the current certificate will overlap by three months.
