1. Proposed variation

The second annual surveillance audit will take place in April, 2015—17 months after the previous surveillance audit, and 7 months after the anniversary of the certification date (Sept. 2012).

2. Rationale/Justification

The NE Sakhalin Island salmon fishery needs additional time to prepare for their surveillance audit (see NE Sakhalin variation request), and there is a desire to keep that fishery and this one on the same surveillance schedule.

The sustainability status of the fishery is not believed to be affected by this change, particularly as the fishery will not be open, and thus there will be no new product entering the supply chain before June/July of 2015. We offer the following justification:

- The results of the previous season's fishery would not be available if the audit were to take
 place according to the existing schedule (Oct/Nov this year), however they will be available in
 April of next year for the assessment team to review thus allowing the most up-to-date
 information to be used for the surveillance audit; and
- 2. Keeping this fishery on the same surveillance schedule as the NE Sakhalin Island salmon fishery will increase efficiency and cost savings for both fisheries and their stakeholders in this remote area of Russia.

3. Implications for assessment (required for fisheries assessment variations only)

There aren't expected to be any negative implications for the assessment. As mentioned above, the fishery is closed until June or July 2015 anyway, and maintaining consistent timing on surveillance audits between Ozernaya and NE Sakhalin Island will ensure efficiency and cost savings for both assessments.
