<b>1. Proposed variation</b>	
Surveillance report will be submitted one month after current deadline of 16 <sup>th</sup> March 2017, making the new deadline the 16 <sup>th</sup> April 2017.	
<b>2. Rationale/Justification</b>	
An extension was previously granted for the submission of these surveillance reports to allow for significant stakeholder input and technical queries requiring clarification from the MSC.
