1. Proposed variation

To extend the certificate of the fishery from 20th June 2017 until the 31st August 2017 (further to an earlier certificate extension request made in March 2016).

2. Rationale/Justification

The PNA Skipjack fishery entered reassessment on the 6th August 2016 and a variation has been submitted to the MSC to extend the deadline for submission of the PCDR to the 6th June 2017 due to harmonisation discussions (further details in that variation). With that extension in place, the 30-day consultation period may run until the 6th of July. The 31st of August is chosen as a reasonable timeframe to allow for the consultation periods required by the assessment process and team responses.
