

Argentine anchovy (*Engraulis anchoita*), Bonaerense stock, semipelagic mid-water trawl net fishery

List of companies and vessels eligible for MSC Certificate

Organización Internacional Agropecuaria S.A. (OIA) is pleased to announce you that vessel's list certified was changed. Centauro S.A. and Alleloccic S.A. will replace their vessels "Desafío" and "Aldebarán" to "Victoria II" and "Mercea C", respectively, and the company Delicias S.A. incorporates in its scope the vessel "Don Raimundo". These vessels have the same fishing gear. There are no differences in mid-water trawl equipment, fishing methods and manoeuvres. Both vessels are identified as eligible in the full-assessment and in the actually re-certification process.

The impact in the ecosystem of both vessels was reviewed on the component of Principle 2 in the certification process (2011). So, there is no reason to modify Principle 2 assessment and the impact is maintained.

The following is the list of companies and vessels which are eligible to use the current MSC fishery certificate on Argentine anchovy fishery (F-OIA-P-0200), provide MSC fish products and enter the MSC Chain of Custody as suppliers of certified fish:
