## THE POINT(S) AT WHICH FISH AND FISH PRODUCTS MAY ENTER A CHAIN OF CUSTODY

Only Antarctic krill (Euphausia superba) caught in the manner defined in the Unit of Certification under restrictions detailed throughout the body of the Public Certification Report (January 2015) for this fishery shall be eligible to enter the Chain of Custody. Chain of Custody should commence following the first point of landing, at which point the product shall be eligible to carry the MSC logo. Aker BioMarine does not require its own chain of custody certificate.

The client's own transport vessel transloads the krill from the named fishing vessels and transports the products to Aker BioMarine's facility in Nueva Palmira close to Montevideo, Uruguay.
