Det Norske Veritas (DNV) is pleased to announce that we will be conducting the second Surveillance Audit for the Danish Pelagic Producers Organisation's North Sea Herring Fishery.

The key purpose of the surveillance audit is:

- to review and evaluate the progress of the fishery against Conditions of Certification raised during the full assessment
- review any changes in the management systems
- review changes or additions / deletions to regulations
- review any personnel changes in scientific staff, key management or industry to evaluate impact on the management of the fishery
- review any potential changes to the scientific basis of information

The surveillance audit meetings will be held in Hirtshals and Copenhagen, Denmark during week 26 (27-28 June 2011) and will be conducted by members of the original assessment team Mr. Eskild Kirkegaard and DNV Lead Auditor Ms. Sandhya Chaudhury.
