Accepted variation to the MSC Fisheries Certification Process v2.3 – 7.29.23 for Atlantic Ocean tropical tuna French purse seine

Control Union (UK) Limited (CU UK) would like to inform stakeholders that MSC has accepted a variation request against the MSC FCP v2.3 – 7.29.23 to allow CU UK to publish the Year 1 surveillance report for the Atlantic Ocean tropical tuna French purse seine fishery later than 60 days of completing the surveillance audit. The original deadline was the 25th of March 2025 and, therefore, it has been now extended till the 24th of April 2025.
