Announcement of Determination and Release of Final Report for Stakeholder Comment

DNV GL is pleased to announce that following the 30 day period of stakeholder comment on the Public Comment Drat Report, the Assessment team at DNV GL has reviewed the report which includes the Peer reviewer comments and all stakeholder comments.

DNV GL's assessment team has reached the Determination that the Norway North Sea and Skagerrak herring (*Clupea harengus*) fishery targeted in North Sea and Skagerrak; ICES Division IV and IIIa within EEZ of Norway (FAO area 27) using Pelagic trawl and purseseining as harvesting method (as defined in the accompanying report) should be certified according to the Principles and Criteria for Sustainable Fisheries set by the Marine Stewardship Council.

The Final Report for this reassessment is now available on the MSC website. Please note that this is a determination and not a final certification result. The fishery is not recertified until the final consultation period of 15 working days has been concluded. In this period a party may lodge a statement of intent to object on either merit grounds (if the party has previously provided input to the assessment team) or procedural grounds (if any party has been prevented from earlier participation in the assessment process). Additionally any party (regardless of prior participation) may file support of a merit objection.
