1. Proposed variation

To extend the certificates for the following fisheries: DFPO Denmark North Sea plaice (expires 30th September 2017), DFPO Denmark North Sea & Skagerrak cod & saithe (expires 30th September 2017), DFPO Denmark North Sea sole (expires 6th June 2017), DFPO Denmark North Sea & Skagerrak haddock (expires 6th August 2017). The proposed variation is to extend these certificates to 1st March 2019.

2. Rationale/Justification

The DFPO fisheries listed above are being assessed under the Joint demersal fisheries in the North Sea and adjacent waters assessment. This assessment is being undertaken by another CAB (MEC) and is scheduled to conclude in early 2019. The DFPO fisheries will be covered by this certificate provided the successful passing of this assessment. The proposed variation and proposed extension will allow for continued certification of these fisheries.

In order to ensure continued compliance with the Standard we will conduct surveillance audits for these fisheries in January 2018. These will demonstrate that the fisheries are still meeting the Standard. It is worth noting that all four fisheries currently have no open conditions which need monitored.

3. Implications for assessment (required for fisheries assessment variations only)

Acoura can confirm that we have no reasons to doubt the ability of the fisheries to meet the Standard and the planned surveillance audits will demonstrate this.
