## Release of the Final Report

SCS is pleased to announce the release of the Final Report for the Fishery. The assessment team has reviewed all comments on the report and supporting documentation and has determined that the fishery meets the MSC requirements for a well-managed and sustainable fishery.

This is not the final determination. The determination is now open for a final objection period no less than 15 working days. Any stakeholder that has participated in the assessment thus far may lodge an objection on the positive certification decision.
