

Hokkaido Scallop Fishery

Announcement of Determination and Release of Final Report for Stakeholder Consultation

Following a 30 day period of comment on the Public Certification Report, the independent Governing Board of the certification body, Moody Marine Ltd, has reviewed the report of the assessment team, the reports of the Peer Review panel and all stakeholder comments.

The Determination reached by Moody Marine is that the Hokkaido Scallop Fishery SHOULD be certified according to the MSC Principles and Criteria.

The Final Report relating to this assessment is now available on the MSC's website.

Please note that this is a determination, not a final certification result until the final consultation period has been concluded.
