History of the Fishery	Fishing is recorded as far back as 1846 with fishing on a seasonal basis for subsistence and was linked with the river steamer and barge trade on the River Murray. Commercial fishing supplying local markets is recorded in 1906. Following construction of the barrage system across the lakes there was up to 64 licensed fishers operating in the region. Regulation (limited entry) and licensing has seen that number drop to the 36 licences that exist today.
