Fortuna Pacific longline albacore, bigeye and yellowfin tuna fishery

Control Union (UK) Limited (CU UK) would like to inform stakeholders of an update to the timing of the Fortuna Pacific longline albacore, bigeye and yellowfin tuna fishery full assessment.

The original announcement stated that the site visit was to be held from the week commencing 3rd April 2023. The site visit will now be held **on the week of 15th May 2023** in the same location (Kaohsiung, Taiwan).

Stakeholders are encouraged to provide comments on the Announcement Comment Draft Report (ACDR) published on the MSC website for this fishery. Stakeholders may raise issues with the team in confidence for the team to consider at the site visit, but any confidential information cannot be used in scoring unless in compliance with confidentiality requirements.

Information can be kept confidential if it is restricted to financial transactions about certification, the financial affairs of individual companies or information that may lead to this information being known, or information that is the subject of relevant national privacy or data protection legislation in the assessed fishery’s country.
