## **Release of Public Comment Draft Report**

The draft report on the MSC certification re-assessment of the South African Hake Trawl Fishery is now available for comment by stakeholders. The report is available at the MSC website (www.msc.org).

Stakeholders are invited to comment at this stage on the factual content of the report, either in relation to specific scoring indicators or sections in the body of the report. Comments should be clearly related to specific scoring indicators or report sections and any recommendations or criticisms should be supported with data or literature citations that the assessment team is able to evaluate.

If you wish to provide comment at any stage of the assessment process the MSC have provided a template for stakeholders to complete and submit their comments. This can be downloaded <a href="here">here</a>.

Following receipt of comments by stakeholders, Intertek Fisheries Certification will consider all available information and make a determination on whether the fishery should be certified. Following this determination, the final report will be made available for a further 15 working day consultation period.

Intertek Fisheries Certification will notify identified stakeholders of key steps in the assessment process directly through email.
