Public Certification Report

Following a 15-days consultation period of the Final Report and Determination on the initial assessment of the Guyana seabob fishery against the MSC Fisheries Standard, Vottunarstofan Tún confirms that notices of objection were not received during that period.

Vottunarstofan Tún is pleased to announce the release of the Public Certification Report for this fishery. The Guyana seabob fishery within the Guyana EEZ is now certified to the MSC Fisheries Standard from the date of the publication of this report for the remainder of the current certification period, subject to successful outcome of surveillance audits.

The Guyana seabob fishery can now use the MSC ecolabel on products from the Unit of Certification specified in the Public Certification Report, subject to having entered into licence agreement with the owner of the MSC Ecolabel.
