Statement on Conditions in Current Fisheries

This re-assessment combines two multi-species fisheries currently certified as:

- ISF Iceland saithe, ling, Atlantic wolfish and plaice: Originally certified in 2014 for saithe only; ling added by expedited assessment in 2015; Atlantic wolfish and plaice added by expedited assessment in 2017.
- ISF Iceland golden redfish, blue ling and tusk: Originally certified in 2014 for golden redfish only; blue ling and tusk added by expedited assessment in 2017.

At the time of the extensions of scope of those fisheries in 2015 and 2017, conditions were set in respective Public Certification Reports outlining how achieving the 80 level of performance is realistically expected over a period lasting longer than the current certification cycle ("exceptional circumstances" as per 7.11.1.3 of FCR v2.0).

Subsequent to scope extensions, efforts have been made during surveillance assessments to harmonise the two fisheries and to ensure consistency within each extended fishery.

A review of the current status of conditions for those two fisheries is provided in appendix to this statement (Table 1 and Table 2).
