	The certificate for this fishery expires on the 15 th May 2019. The fishery is currently being re-assesed as part of a new combined assessment - Joint demersal fisheries in the North Sea and adjacent waters. This new assessment received a Notice of Objection, with the objection submission period having closed on the 10 th May, delaying the potential certification of this assessment and the re-certification of the plaice fishery as part of this assessment. An automatic extension of 6 months is applied in the event the objection is accepted but this variation is needed to cover the time during which the IA decides on the objection. An extension of the existing certificate for the plaice fishery will prevent a lapse in certification until the eventual conclusion of the Joint demersal fisheries in the North Sea and adjacent waters assessment.
