Announcement of Determination and Release of Final Report for Stakeholder Consultation

Following a 30 day period of comment on the Draft Report, SAI Global Assurance Services, has reviewed the report of the assessment team, the reports of the Peer Review panel and all stakeholder comments.

The Determination reached by the certification body is that the Ireland Bottom Grown Mussel (Mytilus Edulis) Fishery and the linked Northern Ireland Bottom Grown Mussel (Mytilus Edulis) Fishery SHOULD be certified according to the MSC Principles and Criteria.
