Proposed variation

The fishery will not be withdrawn following the 18-month period from date of the on-site assessment visit.

Rationale/Justification

The Grupo Regal Spain Hake Longline Fishery revised timeline has been extended (to show delivery of their final report before the end of February 2014).

The timeline for the DFPO Denmark North Sea, Skagerrak and Kattegat Hake fishery is dependent upon the same limiting factors as the Grupo Regal Spain Hake longline fishery. Therefore, to harmonise with the Grupo Regal fishery, the DFPO assessment timeline should be benchmarked against the same key events.

This will require delivery of the PCDR for the DFPO Hake fishery during or before August 2013. If this deadline is not met, the fishery assessment will be immediately withdrawn in September 2013.
