3 Justification

This is the 2nd recertification for this fishery. The certificate expires on 28.02.2023.

The re-assessesment process for this fishsery started on 10th of February 2022 and initial audit took place remotely during 14-17 of March.

Due to an unexpected change of the client management, the re-assessment process took longer than expected as additional time was required to allow new fisheries manager get up to speed with MSC Standard, re-assessment process and conditions. The fishery re-assessment process is now almost back on track and client action plan was received 13.12.2022 and due to go through the team's approval.

However, this delay presents a risk that re-assessment might not be completed by certificate expiry date on 28.02.2023.

4 Implications for assessment

If this VR is not accepted and re-assessment process is further delayed due to the reasons stated above, the fishery would lose its certificate. Draft determination by the CAB and assessment team is to re-certify the fishery. Thus, the delay of re-assessment does not have any impact on compliance of fishery with the MSC standard.

5 Mitigation of the implications for assessment

No measures are required.

6 How many conditions does the fishery have?

There are 3 new conditions to the fishery, not related to any previously raised condition.

Assessment is currently at Public Comment Draft Report preparation stage.
