	During the first surveillance audit (2019), new information related with unwanted catch of target species was reviewed, generating that PI 1.2.1 must be re-scored. The information available to team members gives no evidence of alternative measures being so far conducted. So, it is concluded that there has been not such studies which could help minimize the unwanted catch of the target stock. So, the fishery does not meet with the SG60 level. So, the fishery FAILS in the PI 1.2.1.
	According GCRv2.3 – 7.4.2.a, the fishery is suspended, due it no longer conforms to the MSC Fisheries Standards.

- The suspension requires that the certificate holder not sell any fish caught as MSC-certified after the effective date of suspension until such time that the suspension is lifted. To comply with this requirement, the fishery is not eligible to use the MSC ecolabel (GCR 7.4.3).

The suspension requires that certificate holders (ESTREMAR S.A., EMPRESA PESQUERA DE LA PATAGONIA Y ANTÁRTIDA S.A. and SAN ARAWA S.A.) not sell any fish caught as MSC-certified after the effective date of suspension (21 June 2019) until such time that the suspension is lifted. Fish caught prior to that date may continue to be sold after effective date of suspension as MSC Certified. OIA can confirm the certificate holders' ability to segregate fish based on date of capture according Daily Production On board Report. This record is mandatory in the fishery management.
