BUREAU VERITAS Certification is pleased to announce that the Final Report (FR) has been published after the 30-day public consultation period for receiving comments on the PCDR. The Final Report is now available for stakeholder consultation.

The team found that the fishery complies with the MSC-Fisheries Requirements (FCR v2.0) for Principle 1. Thus, **THE DETERMINATION OF BOTH THE TEAM AND BUREAU VERITAS IS FOR THE MSC-FISHERY CERTIFICATE TO REMAIN ACTIVE**. Please note that this is a determination, not a final certification result.

There is now a **15 UK working day period** during which any party that disagrees with this determination, and that has previously provided input to the assessment team (or can establish that necessary procedures were not followed to seek their involvement prior to this point), may send a written statement of intent to lodge an objection.
