Following a 15-day objection period on the Final Draft Report for the CHILE SQUAT LOBSTERS DEMERSAL TRAWL CAMANCHACA FISHERY, the **Public Certification Report** was produced by the assessment team and published at the MSC website on March 10, 2022 (click [here](#) to download it).

Both the assessment team and Bureau Veritas Certification Holding SAS agree that the CHILE SQUAT LOBSTERS DEMERSAL TRAWL CAMANCHACA FISHERY complies with MSC Principles and Criteria and determined that fishery should be re-certified against the MSC-fishery standard. The fishery will keep certified for five years, subject to the results of ongoing surveillance audits.

The client Camanchaca Pesca Sur, S.A. is the only eligible to use the MSC fishery certificate and sell fishery products as certified. The product caught by the Unit of Certifications presented in the table below is eligible to be sold by the client group as MSC certified and enter further certified CoC without restrictions.

Only yellow squat lobster and red squat lobster caught in the manner defined in the UoC, and traced and segregated according to the description provided in the PCR are eligible to be sold by the Camanchaca Pesca Sur as MSC-Fisheries certified product and enter further Chain of Custody (CoC) without restrictions.

Given the vertical integration of Camanchaca the chain of custody will commence before the change of ownership. The traceability of the product is covered by the certificate of the fishery until the entrance in the processing plant following the first point of unloading.

Nylon shrimp, yellow squat lobster and red squat lobster shall be landed in authorised ports and subject to inspection by the Sernapesca, as required by the Chilean Fishery Law. The Camanchaca fleet (and the

other eligible vessels when operating for Camanchaca) are normally landing at the ports of San Antonio and Tomé, although they might use other authorised ports if designated by Camanchaca.

The client group certificate covers the following companies on behalf of the conditions stated in the certificate sharing: Sociedad Pesquera Isla Damas S.A; Pesquera Sunrise S.A; Pesquera CMK Ltda.; Sociedad Pesquera Genmar Ltda.; Jorge Cofre Reyes; y Gonzalez, Koper y Martinez Ltda. The list of vessels belonging to these companies and included in the UoC is available at the MSC website.

**Camanchaca Pesca Sur is the only party eligible to use the MSC-fisheries certificate and sell products as MSC-Fishery certificated.**
