

MSC EVALUATION OF THE

ANNETTE ISLANDS RESERVE SALMON FISHERY

ANNOUNCEMENT of FISHERY CERTIFICATION & PUBLIC CERTIFICATION REPORT

The Marine Stewardship Council (MSC) process for independently evaluating the fishery above has concluded and the fishery may now be certified as a source of sustainable seafood.

This certification decision comes after a period where stakeholders had the opportunity to object to the assessment team's positive final determination. No objections were received, and the SCS certification board has approved the determination for a positive certification decision.

The certificate is valid for a period of 5 years with periodic surveillance visits to ensure continued compliance with the MSC standard. SCS would like to congratulate the client group on this achievement.
