Scottish Fisheries Sustainable Accreditation Group (SFSAG) North Sea haddock fishery

MEC Certification Ltd (MEC) is pleased to announce that following the thirty (30) day period of stakeholder comments on the Public Comment Draft Report (PCDR), the Final Report (FR) for this fishery has now been published on the MSC website (www.msc.org).

MEC's Final Report (FR) concludes that the Scottish Fisheries Sustainable Accreditation Group (SFSAG) North Sea haddock fishery should be re-certified according to the Principles and Criteria for Sustainable Fisheries as set by the Marine Stewardship Council.

The Final Report for this assessment is now available on the MSC website. Please note that this is a determination and not a final certification result. The fishery is not certified until the final consultation period of 15 working days has been concluded. In this period a party may lodge either a Procedural Objection or a Merits Objection.
