## Stakeholder Consultation: RBF Workshop Announcement

The re-assessment of these fisheries has been delayed due to the absence of critical information on the fishery.

Accordingly, a variation has been requested, and granted, to allow use of the Risk-Based Framework as part of the assessment of the fisheries (RBF), see: <u>http://www.msc.org/about-us/standards/methodologies/fam/msc-risk-based-framework</u>). This is a stakeholder informed qualitative analysis. To achieve a robust outcome from this consultative approach, this analysis relies heavily on the participation of a suitably broad range of stakeholders with a good balance of knowledge of the fishery.

The areas we will be using the RBF for are: Pikeperch stock status (PI 1.1.1) Retained species (other than pikeperch) status (PI 2.1.1) Bycatch (discard) species status (PI 2.2.1) Benthic habitat effects (PI 2.4.1) Ecosystem effects (PI 2.5.1)

As a site-visit has already taken place, this RBF workshop will take the form of a teleconference with interested stakeholders.
