1 Proposed variation

The 3rd Surveillance Report of the fishery has been scheduled to be published on 29th September (considering the 90 days period on which the CAB shall upload the Surveillance report to the MSC database if the client revises the Client Action Plan, following FCP 7.28.23.1). However, Bureau Veritas requests to extend the publish date of this 3rd surveillance report until 29th November 2022 due to harmonisation with overlapping fisheries.

3 Justification

The closing meeting was held on 29th July 2022, however, a new condition was identified by the assessment team and FCP 7.28.20.1 allows a period of 30 extra days for the client to prepare a Client Action Plan.

There are three overlapping fisheries with Echebastar: (i) AGAC four oceans Integral Purse Seine tropical tuna fishery, (ii) CFTO Indian Ocean Purse Seine Skipjack Fishery and (iii) Maldives pole & line skipjack tuna fishery.

Taking into consideration the information reviewed during the current surveillance audit, the BV team would like to discuss scores on PI 1.2.1, 1.2.2 and 3.2.3 with the other overlapping fisheries. Thus, on September 1st BV contacted the other CABs for harmonisation. Control Union and Global Certification Trust (assessing the CFTO and the Maldives fisheries, respectively) answered that their teams will only be available to fully engage on harmonisation discussions during October and November since the dates for their audits are as follows:

- On August 26^{th,} Control Union announced the 1st Surveillance audit of CFTO Indian Ocean Purse Seine Skipjack Fishery.
- Maldives pole & line skipjack tuna will announce its 4th surveillance audit and reassessment by the end of September and the visit will take place early November, as informed by the CAB.

Thus, in order to align outcomes and scores between CABs, BV is requesting a variation against FCP2.2 7.28.20.1 and 7.28.23 to delay for 2 months the publication of the 3rd Surveillance report of the Echebastar Indian Ocean purse seine skipjack tuna fishery.

4 If a fishery assessment, implications for assessment

There are no negative implications for the assessment if the request is accepted. This circumstance will be adequately reported in the 3rd Surveillance Report of the fishery.

5 If a fishery assessment, mitigation of the implications for assessment

As there will be no implications for the assessment, no mitigation will be needed.

If a fishery assessment, how many conditions does the fishery have and will their progress be affected (positive or negative)?

The fishery is facing its 3rd surveillance audit with 9 open conditions on the following PIs: 1.2.1, 1.2.2, 2.3.3, 2.4.1, 2.4.3, 2.5.3, 3.1.2, 3.2.1 and 3.2.2. The result of the harmonisation discussions would affect the progress of conditions on PI 1.2.1, PI 1.2.2.
