Assessment Timeline

MSC assessments proceed through a prescribed series of stages. On the basis of experience a minimum of 9 months is required for completion, but the time taken may be considerably longer if delays are encountered. Due to the complexity of this fishery it is anticipated that the period required will be 13 months.

The main sequence of activities is set out below, with the time required for each stage. A delay at any stage will extend the overall timeframe.
