1. Proposed variation

To extend the deadline for the publication of the Final Report until 11th August 2016.

2. Rationale/Justification

The CAB updated the timeline in April 2016 justifying de delay of the PCDR due to Bureau Veritas Iberia temporal suspension. In addition, the new information period published in December and the use of the MSC fisheries requirements version (2.0) announcement in June 2015 has influenced in the team performance of the fishery assessment throughout the assessment process. The exclusion of the blue shark units of certification also has had implications in the writing of the Preliminary Draft Report.

Upon further consultation with the team and client, the deadline of the 11th of August could be achieved if all the next steps in the process are undertaken with the minimum amount of feedback from the client and peer reviewers.

This extended deadline will allow the client the time needed to prepare the Action Plan of the conditions raised in the Preliminary Draft Report.
