	The Joint demersal fisheries in the North Sea and adjacent waters (JDF) includes the following Principle 1			
	stocks: - Cod (<i>Gadus morhua</i>) in Subarea 4, Division 7.d and Subdivision 3.a.20 (North Sea, eastern English Channel,			
	Skagerrak) and; - Whiting (<i>Merlangius merlangus</i>) in Subarea 4 and Division 7.d (North Sea and eastern English Channel).			
	The assessment reached the Final Report stage on the 16 th April 2019 with a Notice of Objection received on the 23 rd May 2019. The objection process is still ongoing.			
	Following the publication of ICES advice for both stocks on the 28 th June 2019 and harmonisation activiti with other certified fisheries, both stocks are currently no longer in conformity with Principle 1 Performan Indicators. As a result, all JDF UoAs that include both these stocks will be self-suspended simultaneously with the publication of the JDF Public Certification Report and certificate, pending the successful outcome of transcessment.			
	A number of other fisheries certified for North Sea cod and whiting have already been suspended, it is of importance that there is no delay whereby North Sea cod and whiting catch stemming from the JDF can be sold as MSC certified. Therefore, it is proposed that the 30 day notice period for suspension is disregarded and will take immediate effect from the date of publication of the JDF Public Certification Report and certificate.			
4	If a fishery assessment, implications for assessment			
	Given that this assessment is subject to an objection, there is opportunity for stakeholders to be informed directly regarding the self-suspension, should this Variation Request be accepted. Acceptance of the variation request will result in suspension of the North Sea cod and whiting UoAs from this fishery on the same date as certification. This will mean that no North Sea cod and whiting caught by the client group will be eligible for sale as MSC certified product.
