Announcement of Determination and Release of Final Report for Stakeholder Consultation

Following a 30-day period of comment on the Public Comment Draft Report, SAI Global, has reviewed the report of the assessment team, the reports of the Peer Reviewers and all stakeholder comments.

The Determination reached by SAI Global is that the above fishery SHOULD be certified according to the MSC Principles and Criteria and SHOULD be awarded continuing certification.
