Notification - Site Visit using RBF

This fishery is entering the 'information gathering' stage of the assessment against the MSC Principles and Criteria for Sustainable Fishing.

A key purpose of the site visit is to collect information and speak to stakeholders with an interest in the fishery. For those parts of the assessment involving the MSC's Risk Based Framework (RBF, see http://www.msc.org/about-us/standards/methodologies/fam/msc-risk-based-framework), we will be using a stakeholder-driven, qualitative analysis during the site visit.
