## Invitation to Stakeholders for Submission of New Information

## SATHOAN French Mediterranean Bluefin tuna artisanal longline and handline fishery

Control Union Pesca Ltd (CU Pesca) is currently undertaking the full assessment of the SATHOAN French Mediterranean Bluefin tuna artisanal longline and handline fishery.

This fishery was announced on the 27 September 2018, and the Public Comment Draft Report (PCDR) was due to be published on the 27 June 2019. The period between the assessment announcement and receipt of the PCDR by the MSC now exceeds 9 months and therefore, as per clause 7.3.4.1 of the MSC Fisheries Certification Requirements 2.0, CU Pesca would like to invite any new stakeholders submissions that the team should consider in the assessment of the fishery.

The period of consultation will last 30 days, the deadline is therefore **17:00 UTC, 27<sup>th</sup> July 2019**. A revised timeline has been published on the MSC's website.
