Surveillance Audit

MSC certification requires annual surveillance audits of all certified fisheries. These audits have two principal functions:

- 1. To review any changes in the management of the fishery, including regulations, key management or scientific staff or stock evaluation
- 2. To evaluate the progress of the fishery against any Conditions of Certification raised during the Main Assessment

In undertaking the audit for the Alaska Salmon Fisheries we shall be meeting with the Alaska Department of Fish and Game. We are also providing opportunity for representatives of the fisheries and environmental organisations to meet with the audit team and present any information relevant to the two points above.

We expect to carry out most meetings over the period 19th – 23rd May 2008 in Anchorage.
