Remote Site Visit Notification

Mussel translocation into the Oosterschelde from The Netherlands, Denmark, Germany, UK and Ireland

MacAlister Elliott and Partners Ltd. (MEP) is undertaking a modified full MSC assessment for the translocation of mussels into the Oosterschelde from MSC certified mussel fisheries in The Netherlands, Denmark, Germany, UK and Ireland. The translocation activities are carried out by the *Members of the Vereniging van Importeurs van Schelpdieren* and *Producenten Organisatie voor de Nederlandse Mosselcultuur UA*, the clients for this assessment. As part of the modified full MSC assessment process (see http://www.msc.org/track-a-fishery/fisheries-in-the-program/in-assessment/north-east-atlantic/mussel-translocation-into-the-oosterschelde/assessment-downloads), a remote site visit will replace the on-site audit. MEP hereby announces that a remote site visit is scheduled to take place on the 20th April 2015.

Furthermore, information that cannot be shared with any other stakeholder will not be referenced in the assessment and cannot be used in determining the outcome of the fishery's assessment nor used as a basis for an objection. Information can be kept confidential if it is restricted to financial transactions about certification, the financial affairs of individual companies or information that may lead to this information being known, or information that is the subject of relevant national privacy or data protection legislation in the assessed fishery's country.

The deadline for consultation is 17:00 GMT on 17th April 2015.
